Welcome to Petersburg

The small and vibrant town of Petersburg is located at the northern end of Mitkof Island, Alaska. It was founded in 1890 by a Norwegian fisherman named Peter Buschmann, who was interested in using ice from nearby LeConte glacier to pack halibut and salmon for shipping. Petersburg's Norwegian heritage is a prominent and lively part of this true fishing village.

Before the town was founded the Tlingit people were very familiar with the bounty of this area and many Alaska Natives still call Petersburg home. Remnants of fish traps and petroglyphs can be found close to town.

While you're in Petersburg, there's lots to see and do. Hiking, flightseeing tours, sports fishing, and wildlife viewing are just some of the options.

Getting to Petersburg is easy. Alaska Airlines offers daily flights from Seattle.



What to Do

Walks from Town

Sandy Beach - Easy/Level

Distance - Approx. 4-5 Miles Round-trip.
Head out of town on Nordic Drive. Nordic Drives curves to the right and becomes Sandy Beach Road. Follow to Sandy Beach. Look for petroglyphs, go tidepooling or birdwatching.

Muskeg Walk - Easy/Slight hill

Distance - Approx. 1.5 Miles
Start at Excel St. and walk uphill to the baseball fields. Go left along the right side of the baseball field to the trail head. Look for carnivorous sundew plants.
